### Engagement Framework – Last Updated June 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2011

**Purposes:** This document is intended to provide a framework for DFO and First Nations engagement toward the establishment of collaborative arrangements for managing Fraser River salmon.

This version is designed specifically for Campbell River FSR Workshop participants and will be revised based on suggestions raised at this workshop and subsequently from input from other First Nations alliances and communities as well as DFO.
