Action Items from September 19, 2017 Meeting with the RDG and notes on follow-up

Steelhead:

Action Item 1: Jennifer will follow up on the Rec fishing with the Province on catch and release fishery in the lower Fraser.

(Note: This refers to the recreational catch and release steelhead fishery on the Lower Fraser.

Recreational fishers are permitted to retain two hatchery steelhead over 50 cm per day, retention of wild steelhead is not permitted)

Follow Up: Further dialogue is likely required and measures should align with whatever decision is made regarding other salmon fisheries in the Lower Fraser during the proposed time frame.

Action Item 2: Jeff Grout will consult with FN on the model developed/review and he asked PM about the appropriate way to do that.

(Note: This refers to the model that looks at the location of steelhead as they move through the fisheries) **Follow-Up:** The model developed by the department was reviewed at the FRAFS JTWG on December 5, 2017. (Complete)

Action Item 3: Andy Thomson says he will make sure that Steelhead is on the agenda at the next meeting between the RDG and the ADM's.
