Summary of Points – May 31, 2018

- Clarity around Canada's FSC fisheries and Treaty exemption
 - Tier 1 process needed to discuss this and how its shared
- Interest in raising current AFE of 400,000
 - More information required on the trade-off, including the value to U.S., cost to Canada, and impact on FN
 - Need to understand the analysis undertaken in 2013, if records are available
 - Need to explore risks (through a retrospective analysis) and what acceptable trade-offs might be
- Flexibility with the number of Management Units

Summary of Points – May 31, 2018

- Concerns about the appointment process and representation of FN Commissioners, and Panel members
 - Need to recognize what is outlined in UNDRIP (e.g. article 18 &19) and how we move forward with implementation
- Conservation is a priority and should be carried through in the negotiations (i.e. 'How do we grow the pie?')
- Request for technical information to support further discussions on Alaska's catch, including:
 - Reasons why we don't address this issue now
 - What Alaska's catch is and the circumstances around it
