At this time, DFO is unable to provide information specific to only Fraser bound stocks. However, catch in all south coast fisheries is provided each year to the Pacific Salmon Commission in the form of a report. The report contains several tables of catch. This hand-out includes the tables provided to the Pacific Salmon Commission in December 2014. Some of the tables have been amended from the December version if errors were noticed.
